Public Displays of Affection

Rationale:

Landsdale Christian School recognizes the importance of students being friendly and showing care towards others.

Purpose:

To guide students in their public display of affection to other students and teachers.

Guidelines:

1. Students are prohibited from showing public affection towards other students (eg. Hugging for an extended amount of time, kissing, touching, holding hands) regardless of whether students are in a relationship or not.
2. Students showing public affection to other students will be given an appropriate penalty, ranging from a infringement to possible suspension, depending upon the situation.
3. Continual disregard of this policy will result in the student being placed on a report card and parents notified.
4. It is the responsibility of all students to remain in the view of the duty teacher during break times.
