### WA STUDENT ASSISTANCE PAYMENT

The state government recently announced a one-off Student Assistance Payment for families with school-aged children (\$250 payment for each secondary student, and \$150 for each primary school student or kindergartener). You will need a valid WA Student Number (WASN) to be eligible for the payment. **We will email parents and guardians this information next week.** The payments will be available through the ServiceWA app from the start of Term 2 (April 15), and we encourage you to use the coming weeks to set up your ServiceWA account and digital identity. # What's a WASN?

A WASN is the WA student number issued by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA) at the time of enrolment.

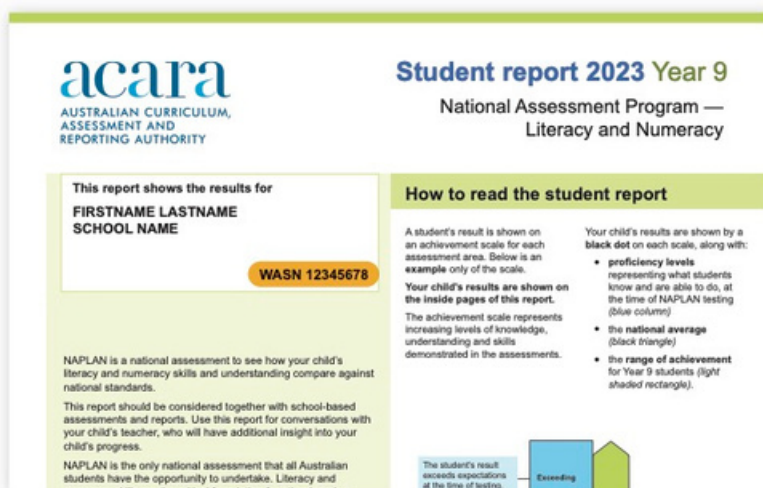
It is an 8-digit number and is sometimes called a SCSA or student number. This number can be found on school reports, including previous NAPLAN results. It may also be on a secondary student's SmartRider.

If your child is in Kindergarten or if you need assistance to identify your WASN, contact your school.
