Year 11 Trip to Sydney & Canberra



Our Year 11 Cohort has recently undertaken an education tour of Canberra. Students participated in education programs at Parliament House, The Museum of National Democracy, The National Electoral Education Centre, The Australian War Memorial and The National Museum. The education programs focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy and complement their learning programs. The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education.

To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion, the Australian Government is contributing funding to Landsdale Christian School in the amount of \$510 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate Programme towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.

In Sydney, the Year 11s also spent time exploring the city, Manly and Bondi. We also stayed and toured Avondale University which offers boarding accommodation for students who wish to study there or at nearby universities. It offers many extra-curricular activities for its students, with a strong focus on sports and social activities. Many of our teachers trained at Avondale University, along with some of our LCS alumni, all of whom have wonderful memories of Avondale University.

After the Canberra component, students also spent a day at Corin Forest where they had a snow skiing lesson and enjoyed skiing, snowball fights and building snowmen.
