The Parents and Friends Committee will be holding a Mother's Day gift stall on **Thursday 9 May** at school in the undercover area.

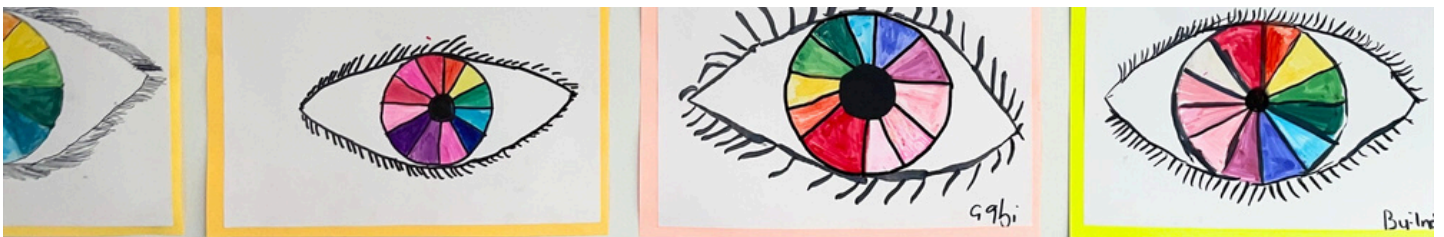

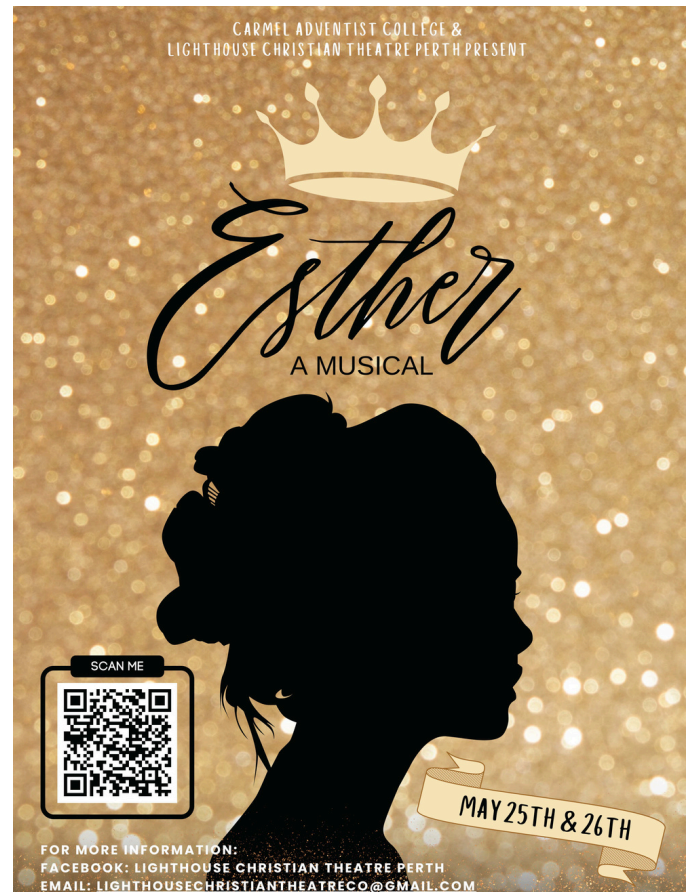
