Adrianna: "My favourite bit at the carnival was cheering on friends."

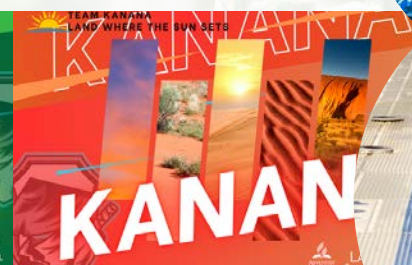
Seth: "The seahorse competition was my favourite one."
